

## **Professional MDF Maintenance**

Whether your company leverages a single switch or a thousand servers, your MDF (Main Distribution Frame) is a reflection of its commitment to best practices.

A well-organized environment with clean, identifiable, and easy to trace patch cables not only looks better, but it can also reduce trouble resolution time by up to 60%.

## **Device Organization**

Arrange equipment in a logical, well planned manner to promote easy access and maximize air flow.

## Equipment Removal / Secure E-Cycling

Dispose of unwanted equipment in a safe, environmentally responsible manner. Under your guidance, a team member will tag items designated for removal. Secure destruction of media is also available. \*

## Cable Management

Replace unnecessarily long and tangled patch cables with short, easily traced patches. This goal is achieved by alternating switches and patch panels to reduce cable length requirements. In some cases, cable length can be reduced to as little as six inches.

A signature color coding scheme facilitates rapid identification of cables by device type. A laminated color key provides easy reference by service personnel.



\*Media destruction services are provided by Iron Mountain. Certificates of destruction are available upon request. Additional handling fees apply.

MDF services are quoted at a flat rate, based on an assessment of the environment. Assessments are free of charge. Before commencement of work, you will be contacted to arrange after-hours access within a pre-defined schedule. (MDF services are typically conducted outside normal business hours to avoid disruption of service.) Upon completion, a Sandbox Technologies Network Engineer conducts a series of pre-defined system checks to verify connection integrity.
